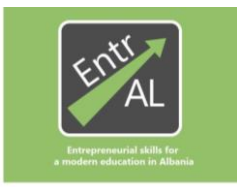

TU Dublin (Aungier Street) is based in the centre of Dublin City. It is a 10 minute walk to Grafton Street, 12 minute walk to Temple Bar and 23 minute walk to O'Connell Street. **Please ensure you are travelling to TU Dublin (Aungier Street)** and not to one of our other campuses dotted across Dublin.

Transport Options:

Airport to Hotel/Aungier Street: TU Dublin is a 35-40 minute car journey from the airport (please give more time during busy commuter hours). It is recommended to take a taxi (fare can range from €25-€36 for four people) or the Dublin Bus (Route: 16) from Dublin Airport (Bus stop: 7347) to Aungier Street (Bus Stop: 1355). 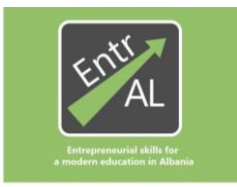

## VI. COVID RESTRICTIONS

Current restrictions for those travelling to Ireland are as follows (as of 24<sup>th</sup> January 2022):

If you are travelling to Ireland from overseas you must [fill out a Passenger Locator Form \(PLF\) before departure.](#)

Passengers to Ireland with:

- an accepted proof of vaccination, **or**
- proof of recovery from COVID-19 in the prior 6 months

do not have to show an additional pre-departure COVID-19 test result.

Passengers without proof of vaccination, or proof of recovery from COVID-19 in the prior 6 months, must show evidence of a negative ('not detected') RT-PCR test result taken within 72 hours prior to arriving in Ireland.

**From 1 February 2022, vaccine certificates for primary vaccination series will not be accepted for travel if more than 270 days have passed since the final dose in the primary vaccine series.**

**Vaccine certificates based on booster/additional doses are not time limited.**

**Further changes will come into effect on 1 February 2022 in relation to the vaccines accepted for travel to Ireland.**

Please note that any Albanian citizen must apply for a visa to travel to Ireland.

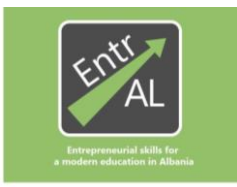
