TU Dublin (Aungier Street) is based in the centre of Dublin City. It is a 10 minute walk to Grafton Street, 12 minute walk to Temple Bar and 23 minute walk to O'Connell Street. Please ensure you are travelling to TU Dublin (Aungier Street) and not to one of our other campuses dotted across Dublin.

Transport Options:

Airport to Hotel/Aungier Street: TU Dublin is a 35-40 minute car journey from the airport (please give more time during busy commuter hours). It is recommended to take a taxi (fare can range from €25-€36 for four people) or the Dublin Bus (Route: 16) from Dublin Airport (Bus stop: 7347) to Aungier Street (Bus Stop: 1355). An adult single bus fare will cost €3.30. Please note that you need to pay for the ticket in exact change (i.e. coins) as you board the bus. (http://www.dublinbus.ie/Fares-and-Tickets/Adult/)

VI. COVID RESTRICTIONS

Current restrictions for those travelling to Ireland are as follows (as of 24th January 2022):

If you are travelling to Ireland from overseas you must <u>fill out a Passenger Locator Form (PLF) before</u> <u>departure.</u>

Passengers to Ireland with:

- an accepted proof of vaccination, or
- proof of recovery from COVID-19 in the prior 6 months

do not have to show an additional pre-departure COVID-19 test result.

Passengers without proof of vaccination, or proof of recovery from COVID-19 in the prior 6 months, must show evidence of a negative ('not detected') RT-PCR test result taken within 72 hours prior to arriving in Ireland.

From 1 February 2022, vaccine certificates for primary vaccination series will not be accepted for travel if more than 270 days have passed since the final dose in the primary vaccine series.

Vaccine certificates based on booster/additional doses are not time limited.

Further changes will come into effect on 1 February 2022 in relation to the vaccines accepted for travel to Ireland.
