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# D.3.2. INTEGRATION OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP COURSES TO THE **EXISTING LLL CENTRES IN ALBANIAN UNIVERSITIES**

**WP3.** Designing of training courses and integration to the TEAVET and U3M-AL Centres. **Lead Organisation:** University of León (P2)

The work package is developed in three phases and deliverables:

- D.3.1. Designing the entrepreneurship courses (3 modules): 1) development of entrepreneurial mind-set for pre-university teachers, 2) entrepreneurship for university teachers, and 3) entrepreneurships for university students.
- D.3.2. Integrating the courses to the existing TEAVET and U3M-AL Centres in Albanian universities.
- D.3.2. Creation of an Albanian Entrepreneurship Network.

The aim of deliverable D.3.1. is to present a comprehensive Working Plan for implementing new courses on entrepreneurship for university teachers, pre-university teachers and university students, and to identify the complementary equipment that is necessary to be bought for successful implementation of activities. This working plan considers:

- 1) LLL Centre positioning in the university as entrepreneurship education provider,
- 2) products or services linked to concrete activities to meet entrepreneurship LLL education needs,
- 3) complementary equipment needed, the need it covers, under with activity will it be used and where will it be installed. ONLY the following items relevant to entrepreneurship can be bought:
- laptops
- flipcharts
- mics
- sound system
- camera
- Internet server
- 4) dissemination strategies, and
- 5) quality assurance procedures to comply with MoESY goals.



#### 1.2. Explain the situation of the LLL Centre in the university organigram and the resources allocated

(Situation in the university organigram and resources currently allocated to run and maintain the Centre during the project and after) (aprox. 200 words)

Aleksandër Moisiu University Durrës and the Faculty of Education at this university, in support of Law no. 80/2015 "On Higher Education and Research in the Institutions of Higher Education in the Republic of Albania", Chapter III, Article 26, other legal acts related to Higher Education in the Republic of Albania, the Statute and the Regulation of UAMD, the Faculty of Education has established the LLL Center for more than 6 years. Although new in its operation, it has been filled with qualified academic staff. The LLL Center is a unique core unit in the academic structure of Aleksandër Moisiu University Durrës and it is part of the Faculty of Education. This center is under the responsibility of the Dean of the Faculty of Education.

LLL Center develops its work by extending it to 3 main lines such as scientific research in education, training and professional qualification of teachers of the pre-university system, care and orientation of students, but also 1 support line such as media relations and publications.

Its academic staff consists of 8 well-qualified members with scientific degrees as well as trained members of the TEAVET project team. However, the center does not function separately from the Faculty, it has cooperative relations with all the staff of the Faculty of Education and all its departments, as well as with other faculties within UAMD.

The LLL Center has been providing "Continuing Education" Master of Science program for about 5 years, and training for teachers belonging to pre-university system, based on the modules developed by the academic staff of the Faculty on Education.

The Center offers studies of the second cycle study programs throughout teaching plans, curricula, qualification courses and accredited training modules; it enables professional training for individuals, institutions or organizations interested in this field such as educational policies and legislation, social education through schools as community centers, contemporary teaching models, assessment of competences of teachers and pupils, identification, prevention and intervention in problematic behavior of teenagers, code of ethics, human rights and the role of the school, communication with pupils, etc. In addition to this center, UAMD and the Faculty of Education with all its study programs as well as the impetuous projects and various activities that it provides, including various courses, offers all the capabilities of life long learning

16 modules designed and accredited during the TEAVET project have been added to the previous trainings of the center. The continuation of these trainings even after the completion of the project, was approved by the Board of Administration at UAMD. Thus the trainings resumed in March 2021 and so far 272 teachers have been trained.

#### 1.3. Explain the potential of the LLL Centre as a provider for entrepreneurship education

(The positioning and potential of the LLL Center in the university, and at regional and national level, as entrepreneurship education provider) (aprox. 200 words)

In the framework of teacher development, the center organizes every year the teachers' forum with their challenges and problems in the pre-university education system. Their works are published in the annual bulletin with ISBN and distributed to school libraries, education directorates and the university.

UAMD has also signed an agreement with the School of Principals, which is in its third generation and the staff of the center, together with a part of the staff of the Faculty of Education, provide training for school principals and all those who aspire to become school principals in the pre-university system. In the second generation, 54 directors and aspirants were trained for 9 months from all over the region of Durres, including Kruje, Fushkruje, Durres, Golem, Rrogozhina, Kavaja. While in the 3rd generation 54 principals and other aspirants are currently being trained who besides Durres work in the preuniversity system in Diber, Mirdita, Permet, Roskovec, Bulqize, Skrapar, Divjake, Mallakaster, Vlora, Himara, etc.

In conclusion we can say that the Master Studies in "Continuing Education" enable the staff of the center to maintain and strengthen relationships with students who complete a bachelor's degree in teaching, but also those who work and want to develop a master program. Trainings for teachers maintain constant relationships and contacts with teachers in the pre-university system and the school of principals helps it to expand and develop relationships in other regions of Albania, from north to south by helping to network the services it offers.

#### 3. **DISSEMINATION AND QUALITY ASSURANCE**
