This working plan considers:

- 2) products or services linked to concrete activities to meet entrepreneurship LLL education needs,
- 3) complementary equipment needed, the need it covers, under with activity will it be used and where will it be installed. ONLY the following items relevant to entrepreneurship can be bought:

  - camera
  - Internet server
- 4) dissemination strategies, and
- 5) quality assurance procedures to comply with MoESY goals.



# 1.2. Explain the situation of the LLL Centre in the university organigram and the resources allocated

(Situation in the university organigram and resources currently allocated to run and maintain the Centre during the project and after) (aprox. 200 words)

CLLL (Life ong Learning Centre) was founded by UGJ, as a result of being involved as a beneficiary partner in the TEAVET project. LLL is a centre that provides training services for pre-university teachers. According to the University organogram, the LLL centre is responsible to the Research and External Relations Office. This centre has implemented the objectives of the TEAVET project under the Erasmus Plus Program entitled "Improving the teaching competencies in Albanian Universities".

The position of the Centre in the University organogram:



The main result of the project was the creation of a system for teacher training in LLL approved by the MoESY, designing and implementing training courses to improve teaching and learning competencies for in-service teachers in line with EU strategies and those of the Ministry of Education, Sports and Youth. The establishment and operation of the LLL centre was preceded by a formal process of registration, accreditation and attendance of teacher training programs, with recognition by the Ministry of Education, Sports and Youth.

The centre is equipped with hardware and software tools to support didactic processes for the training courses. Teachers of the Southern Region and beyond can attend specialized courses in the field of teacher competencies accredited by ASCAP.

Maintenance and other contributions necessary for the successful operation of the centre are presented in the organogram of the LLL Centre.

### 1.3. Explain the potential of the LLL Centre as a provider for entrepreneurship education

(The positioning and potential of the LLL Centre in the university, and at regional and national level, as entrepreneurship education provider) (aprox. 200 words)

Our University LLL Centre bases its work on the national strategy for the Development of Pre-University Education that includes the implementation of a Comprehensive Vocational and Educational Training (VET) System for the professional development of in-service teachers at pre-university level. The TEAVET project through the LLL Centre is contributing to the comprehensive VET system for teachers by developing a Lifelong Learning Teacher Training System of high quality, by means of an accreditation procedure.

The Centre has offered teacher training course programs for different levels of education on scientific methodologies, pedagogical issues, ethics and ICT use in teaching/learning process according to European standards.

The following table presents information on training modules offered to teachers. The modules are accredited by ASCAP (the Quality Assurance Agency in Pre-University Education). The 16 accredited teacher qualification modules were to be carried out in the framework of the TEAVET project, an Erasmus Plus program. Therefore, during 2020, it became possible to provide free courses by EÇUGJ academic staff. The number of trained and certified teachers is 560 in total, in 14 out of the following 16 training modules for teachers.

Based on the successful experience so far, motivation, dedication, engagement and expertise of the academic staff, positive trainee feedback, and continuous engagement in European Projects, it is strongly believed that the LLL Centre has all the intellectual potential to successfully continue its activity as a provider for entrepreneurship education in the framework of the EntrAL Project.

However, there are some problems that need to be dealt with in the course of the project:

The University authorities are considering the possibility of moving the TEAVET Centre ( currently on the 1st floor of Building A) to a more spacious environment in order to meet the needs of an increasing number of interested trainee applicants and products it is going to offer in the framework of this project.

As it may be clearly seen in the University organogram, the LLL centre is currently responsible to the Research and External Relations Office. With the beginning of the new academic year, it

is thought as more appropriate and efficient to include it in the organogram of the Faculty of Education and Social Sciences, under the jurisdiction of the Department of Education and Teaching Methodology.

With these problems being sorted out, it is expected that the LLL Centre is a safe assumption that the Centre is going to operate more efficiently.

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#### 3. DISSEMINATION AND QUALITY ASSURANCE

3.1. Describe the dissemination strategies of the LLL Centre as provider of *entrepreneurship* education (to pre-university teachers, university teachers and university students).

The main target groups of the LLL center operation are as follows:

- Academic staff and researchers interested in entrepreneurship education,
- Pre-university teachers interested in entrepreneurship education
- Incoming and outgoing students interested in entrepreneurship education;
- Business Partners (e.g. Chamber of commerce, etc.);
- Local Educational Institutions
- Alumni.

The following elements are part of the dissemination plan of the LLL Centre:

- The LLL Centre webpage (<a href="https://uogi.edu.al/category/lll/">https://uogi.edu.al/category/lll/</a>) will serve for information purposes about the services and activities provided by the center.
- Immediately after having been trained, staff members involved in LLL Centre activity, apart from taking up their advisory role towards the academic community of their home university, are going to plan at least one local information day and two local seminars.
- Video files with advertising content will be created and published on the webpage and will be
  distributed among the target groups. They will include general information, products and
  services provided by the LLL Centre.
- Internal institutional meetings are to be regularly organized in order to involve all relevant stakeholders from the institution in the implementation of the LLL Centre activities and in the development of reports, guidelines, methodologies, tools, and strategies.
- Organization of round tables and seminars with the local educational community (RED) and authorities, and other relevant stakeholders (e.g. Chamber of Commerce, etc.).
- Leaflets and newsletters will be created and distributed, in order to give detailed information to all target groups. These leaflets and newsletters will be innovatively designed in order to attract a high number of interested people.

# 3.2. Describe the quality assurance procedures of the LLL Centre.

• The Internal Quality Assurance Unit (IQAU) is a structure responsible for drafting policies and procedures for internal quality assurance, implementation and continuous improvement of the quality system in UGJ, based on state quality standards (Quality Code in Higher Education) and European guidelines for quality assurance in the European Higher Education Area. The mission of this unit is to guarantee the implementation of procedures approved by the governing bodies through the control and evaluation of the teaching process in terms of teaching and activities related to it.

#### Approaches and methods for quality assurance

- Certification of trainers
- **Self-evaluation**-LLL Centre put in place a process of self-assessment on an annual basis, according to the statutory framework for quality assurance. The findings are to be presented in the annual report.
- Formative evaluation research- The annual self-assessment of LLL Centre is based on the formative results of (on-going) evaluations and investigations, which include: trainees' survey, trainers' survey, survey of other stakeholders involved, reviews of management principles and evaluations by the Internal Quality Assurance Unit. The findings are to be presented in the annual report. The formative evaluation aims at judging the worth of a program while the program activities are forming (in progress). It will be conducted during any phase of the process. This part of the evaluation will focus on the process. Formative evaluation will also be useful in analyzing learning materials, student learning and achievements, and teacher effectiveness etc. Formative evaluation will be considered primarily a building process which accumulates a series of components of new materials, skills, and problems into an ultimate meaningful whole.
- **Summative evaluation** as a method of judging the worth of a program at the end of the program activities (summation). The focus of this element of evaluation will be on assessing the outcome in order to estimate whether the results of the activities being evaluated have met the stated goals.

The tools for conducting surveys (questionnaires, interviews, etc.)will be provided by the Internal Quality Assurance Unit and Training and Lifelong Learning Centre. The model or methodology used to gather the data will be a specified step-by-step procedure and will be carefully designed and executed to ensure the data is accurate and valid.
