

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### D.3.2. INTEGRATION OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP COURSES TO THE EXISTING LLL CENTRES IN ALBANIAN UNIVERSITIES

**WP3.** Designing of training courses and integration to the TEAVET and U3M-AL Centres. **Lead Organisation:** University of León (P2)

The work package is developed in three phases and deliverables:

- D.3.1. Designing the entrepreneurship courses (3 modules):
  - 1) development of entrepreneurial mind-set for pre-university teachers,
  - 2) entrepreneurship for university teachers, and
  - 3) entrepreneurships for university students.
- D.3.2. Integrating the courses to the existing TEAVET and U3M-AL Centres in Albanian universities.
- D.3.2. Creation of an Albanian Entrepreneurship Network.

The aim of deliverable D.3.1. is to present a comprehensive Working Plan for implementing new courses on entrepreneurship for university teachers, pre-university teachers and university students, and to identify the complementary equipment that is necessary to be bought for successful implementation of activities. This working plan considers:

- 1) LLL Centre positioning in the university as entrepreneurship education provider,
- 2) products or services linked to concrete activities to meet entrepreneurship LLL education needs,
- 3) complementary equipment needed, the need it covers, under with activity will it be used and where will it be installed. ONLY the following items relevant to entrepreneurship can be bought:
  - laptops
  - flipcharts
  - mics
  - sound system
  - camera
  - Internet server
- 4) dissemination strategies, and
- 5) quality assurance procedures to comply with MoESY goals.

RDC has been established as a center for regional development under the U3M project with the purpose of developing the activities of the third mission of universities. Under this center, the LLL teacher training center has been implemented, which has been operating since 2019. The center is accredited by the Academic Senate on February 28, 2018 and later in May 2020 by the Board of Administration of UV for the development of LLL teacher training activities.

The structure of the center contains 2 full time employees, the director and the specialist of the center, as well as the engagement part time of 18 researchers and trainers from the faculties of humanities, the faculty of economics and the faculty of technical sciences where teaching study programs are developed.

#### 1.2. Explain the situation of the LLL Centre in the university organigrama and the resources allocated


(Situation in the university organigram and resources currently allocated to run and maintain the Centre during the project and after) (aprox. 200 words)

The Center of Interdisciplinary studies for Regional Development with LLL Teacher Training integrated already operates according to a business plan approved in 2020 by the UV Board of Administration. Due to the pandemic, the center organizes online training courses for teachers qualification, providing income for the institution as well as for the academic training staff. The center has created a good experience in the occasional launch of teacher training courses as well as a database of enrollees and participants in these courses. Thus, the center offers a quality training service and it is positively evaluated by teachers.

The center, described as interdisciplinary, is allocated in the organigrama as a center depending on the rectory and according to the organization chart of the institution. The center functions according to a regulation of activity management as well as a regulation of integration of academic trainers in the activities of the center. The center is supported by the university budget as part of the university structure. Of the revenue it provides, 60% is used to pay trainers, while 40% is used for expenses and maintenance provided in the annual budget requests.

However, the center needs infrastructure improvements with digital tools that is going to support entrepreunerial training activities.

### 1.3. Explain the potential of the LLL Centre as a provider for entrepreneurship education

The Center of Interdisciplinary studies for Regional Developmenthas created a good experience in promoting and organizing training courses for teachers and academic staff. In these courses, there have been included students of different faculties as well. Over 2000 teachers have been part of the center's activities benefiting from training or research services.

The center has expanded its activity to include academic staff in the development of national and local projects. One of these projects is the modeling of digital classrooms in the elementary education to increase the effectiveness of teaching and learning which is underway. At the national level, the center has developed research proposals on interdisciplinary studies on the construction of training modules for expertise in the application of intelligent systems for the control and maintenance of water systems based on renewable energy. The center is involved in implementing the business club corner for young people by supporting 25 entrepreneurial ideas and potentials.

Academic and support staff are involved in these activities showing potential expertise needed in organizing seminars and workshops that means more support for innovation

and entrepreneurship. The center is equipped with digital tools for the development of further ideas on the benefits of doing business in Albania.

#### 2. DISSEMINATION AND QUALITY ASSURANCE

# 2.1. Describe the dissemination strategies of the LLL Centre as provider of entrepreneurship education (to pre-university teachers, university teachers and university students).

In order to ensure the dissemination and quality assurance, there is the strategy to be implemented, that consists in several actions starting from announcing the project implementation and other services to be updated very soon in the centre. This will be done through UV website and UV FB webpage. Posters will be delivered to show details of EntrAl project objectives. Also two info days will be organized at least with the students and teachers in focus. The academic staff will participate in order to be informed about the new services of the centre and entrepreneurial activities to be organized by the centre. Lecturers of each faculty will be invited to join our centre according to the existed regulation of the centre for trainers and trainees. We have to explain that academic staff can become trainers or candidates of our courses. For purposes of dissemination, we have planned to publish frequently photos and information taken during the activities in order to inform and to encourage students to bring their innovative business ideas and to develop them with the centre support. Teachers of pre-education system will join training activities inviting succesful businesses representatives from Vlora regional to show their experiences that consist in how to start and to develop business. Regional Education Directorate will be a good partner in organizing these training workshop days. As dissemination tolos, we are going to prepare leaftlets and to distribute them in all faculties and schools in order to reach a bigger audience at Vlora community. The electronic versión will be used in FB page.

The centre will promote the students initiative of New Business Idea by inviting and encouraging students to join our centre and to benefit by the partnership through the competitions and awards to winners with the anual best idea of business. In collaboration with schools, we will invite teachers and students of pre education level to join our

ceremonias and promotional events of the centre. The website of the centre, social media, TV and radio will be used for promoting all the activities of the centre in the future.

#### 2.2. Describe the quality assurance procedures of the LLL Centre

The quality assurance is a challenge to be ensured. UV has the Quality Assurance Unit, that will monitor and will follow the new activities of the centre staff and people that are responsable of training courses implementation. This activity requires the devdelopment of a quality monitoring plan that integrates the coordination and organization standards of training courses in the centre, people selected as trainers and the quality of course development, integration of entrepreneurial experiences in these courses. Each course will be followed by a evaluation process completing questionnaires to identify the quality of materials, lectors, the methodology and literature standards, tools applied during the training sessions, etc.

The questionnaires will integrate the evaluation of facilities and modalities of interaction between trainers and trainees. The training sessions will be accessible by the head of the centre who will prepare a short report with a short SWOT analysis to be discussed after the training course.

The questionnaires will be used to gather more information by including the feedback on the new needs and ideas in order to design new modules for teachers training on entrepreneurial teaching skills. It is very important to gather student's evaluation of new teaching methods used by teachers trained. Annual questionnaires will be applied by the centre in order to check the impact of training modules and the effect impact. The questionnaires design is going to find the student's evaluation regarding the new entrepreneurial skills and competences of teachers. These questionnaires will use the online forms in order to ensure the standards of privacy.
